

## **2026 STARS OF TOMORROW AUDITIONS**

Saturday, February 14, 2026 8:30 am – Preliminary rounds begin (tentative) 1:30 pm – Semifinal round (tentative)

The annual Stars of Tomorrow Auditions are open to all eligible Wisconsin high school string, woodwind, brass, and percussion musicians. The top three winners will have the honor of appearing as soloists with the MSO at the Audrey G. Baird Stars of Tomorrow Concert on April 12, 2026. Audition slots are limited and will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis as applications are received.

Each soloist will receive a \$1,000 award. An additional award of \$1,000 will be presented to the soloist judged to have performed exceptionally well with the orchestra at the Stars of Tomorrow Concert, and the other two soloists will each receive a \$250 award. Finalists and honorable mentions will have the opportunity to play side-by-side with musicians of the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra.

# **Contest Rules and Regulations**

## **Eligibility**

The contest is open to high school students who are members of the 2025.26 freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior class and are Wisconsin residents. Former award winners are ineligible for further competition.

Registration for a contestant will not be processed without a fully completed registration form and a \$40.00 registration fee\* payable by credit card, check, or money order to the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra.

#### Repertoire

Contestants must play a piece listed on the approved Stars of Tomorrow repertoire list. The list can be found at mso.org/stars.

### **Contest Rules**

A five-minute portion of the selection will be heard at the audition. The same portion should be used in both rounds of competition. If the selection consists of a single movement with contrasting sections or multiple movements played without pause, the candidate should establish cuts that demonstrate the contrasts for the audition. The candidate should clearly indicate any cuts made in the scores furnished to the judges.

The contestant must be prepared to play a selection from the approved Stars of Tomorrow repertoire list in order to be considered as a soloist with the MSO at the Stars of Tomorrow concert. Otherwise, the contestant will only be considered for participation in the side-by-side portion of the concert. Contestants must furnish their own instrument for all aspects of this competition.

Contestants must provide contest judges with an **original** copy of their selection as well as perform from an original copy. Photocopies are not acceptable.

Contestants must provide their own pianist and include the pianist's name, phone number, and signature on their application. Both the contestant and the pianist must be available for both rounds of competition on February 14, 2026. The MSO must be notified of any pianist changes. No pianist changes can be made after January 20, 2026. The MSO does not provide pianists.

MSO musicians will serve as judges for both rounds and their decisions will be final.

If a contestant submits an application fee and decides not to proceed with an audition, the contestant needs to notify the MSO by February 7 to receive a refund. Cancellations following this date will not receive a refund.
