- Distinction between first and second violin will be determined at a later date
- Start Date: September 2027
- Season Length: 41 weeks
- Annual Minimum Salary (2026–27 Season): \$78,835.21 (\$1,922.81/week)
- Annual Minimum Salary (2027–28 Season): \$81,594.51 (\$1,990.11/week)
- 5 collective paid vacation weeks per season
- Health, dental, vision, instrument, and long-term disability insurance
- Guaranteed 8 weeks paid maternity/paternity leave
- 4 personal business days per season
- 403(b) retirement plan
